#### Letter from Golf Committee Chairman, Andrew Bard

Dear MHCC Golfing Members,

I want to thank my committee, Todd Firestone and Jared Weight for assisting in putting together the golf calendar for the 2023 season. Our goal for the 2023 season was to get all the events on the calendar before we close the golf course on August 1, 2023 for the renovation project but respect the ability for members to make tee times for a shortened golf season.

#### A Few Important Notes for the 2023 season:

- Meridian Hills CC is celebrating their Centennial Year and the golf shop will have a special logo that will only be available on apparel for the 2023 season.
- MEMBER RECIPROCAL options from August 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024 will be available at all the private clubs in the Indy area. Members will be able to play at Broadmoor CC for just a cart fee. All other private clubs will have a discounted guest fee.
- We will have 4 "Day Away's" in August and September for 40 members to participate and play courses that have had a golf course renovation in the last couple of years (see the locations and dates on the golf calendar in the packet).
- The start time for the major golf events for the Men will be going back to a 1:00 pm shotgun and the formats will be based on the number of participants.
- Ol Buddy Event will have 4 specific dates in May to play Round 1 & 4 Specific dates in June to play Round 2. The third round has the whole month of July to be played and the Final 4 matches will be played at Broadmoor CC (see the packet for more details).
- Member Monday Events are back, and the dates will be Monday, June 5 & Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup>. A golf member can bring up to 23 guests and the field will be 80 players per event. This event is a great way to entertain your most important clients! Entry fee is \$450 per player that includes lunch, dinner, golf and a "special favor for each player".

#### Letter from Handicap Committee

Dear MHCC Golfing Members,

As you know, the Handicap Committee was created as a subdivision of the Meridian Hills Golf Committee to monitor the handicaps of our golf members. The role of the Handicap Committee is to attempt to ensure the integrity and accuracy of the handicaps of all golfers at Meridian Hills. To accomplish the objectives of the Handicap Committee, a policy was implemented requiring all Meridian Hills golfing members to post scores of any rounds that were played under the rules of golf. This "posting" was done by either depositing scorecards in various boxes around the premises or by simply informing a member of the Golf Staff of the score. Meridian Hills members were no longer able to manually enter scores online, either for scores at Meridian Hills or at another course.

As a result of this policy, the Golf Committee observed that more scores were posted in 2021 and 2022 than prior years, resulting in what the Golf and Handicap Committees believe are more accurate handicaps for our members. While we understand that this is not a perfect policy, we believe the handicap policy had a positive effect on the competitiveness and overall fairness of our golf events. The Golf Committee believes this is shown by the diverse group of high finishers that we have had across the variety of tournaments at Meridian Hills.

To better monitor members' handicaps, the Handicap Committee will be tracking rounds played by members, the percentage of scores posted, tournament scores, and any abnormally large variances. This information will provide an objective measure of the effectiveness of the "posting" policy as well as the accuracy of our members' handicaps. EVERY MEMBER CAN ALSO DOWNLOAD THE INDIANA GOLF APP AND POST THEIR OWN SCORES – SEE THE PAGE IN PACKET ON HOW TO DOWNLOAD!

With the implementation of the new World Handicap System, timely posting of scores will be imperative for any adjustments made by the system relating to the difficulty of a particular day. Please note that the failure to post scores accurately and consistently could result in sanctions being issued by the Handicap Committee. Sanctions could include a player's handicap being adjusted until an appropriate number of scores have been posted or a player being determined to be ineligible for tournament play for a similar period of time. Such sanctions would only be issued after appropriate notice and only in the most egregious of situations. To date, no such sanctions have been imposed and the Handicap Committee sincerely hopes that is the case again in 2023.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding the Meridian Hills Handicap Policy or the procedure for posting scores, please contact myself or a member of the Professional Staff so that any concerns can be addressed. The Handicap Committee is looking forward to an exciting new golf season. We wish you a great year and hope that you play your best golf ever.

#### Dear MHCC Ladies Golf Members:

Welcome to the 2023 golf season! We are very excited about the upcoming year's events as well as some great new clinic and instructional programming. Continuing this year will be the 9 & 18 hole ladies golf on Tuesday mornings which will start after Opening Day on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Again, this is an open invitation to all female golf members at MHCC to encourage new golfers and golfers that have an extremely busy schedule; there are no ladies' association dues at the beginning of the season, this is to alleviate any burden to committing to a whole summer of golf.

#### 9&18 Hole Groups

Tuesday mornings offer several options to accommodate all our female golfers. We will offer formats that are just for fun and formats that are competitive each Tuesday. To sign-up, either call the Golf Shop or register through the ForeTees app. Each week, you will be able to sign-up for the 9 hole or 18-hole group. There is no entry fee to play in the 9-hole group. With the 18-hole group there will be a different competitive format each week that will require a small entry fee which will be paid out in Golf Shop credit. Both 9 & 18 Hole groups will be a 9:00 am shotgun start throughout the season. The 9-hole golfers will have their own optional lunch following golf around 11:00 am, and the 18-hole golfers will have their own optional lunch following golf around 1:00 pm. Depending on your schedule, you could play 9 holes one week and 18 holes another week – this is the flexibility this program offers!

Ladies are still encouraged to play on Thursday mornings but there will be no official game through the golf shop. To play, ladies can make tee times as they do regularly through the Foretees app.

#### Interclub

The MHCC ladies have decided not to participate in the Interclub matches for the 2023 golf season due to scheduling and lack of participation. This is something that we can revisit in the future.

#### **Golf Committee**

The ladies golf committee for 2023 will include Jane Held, Carolyn McClamroch, Gini Hupfer, Beth Morton, Lori Mail and Leisa Merrell. The golf committee has also formed a handicap committee that will ensure all scores will be posted per USGA standards and that all golfers have the minimum of 5 rounds posted to play in a lady's event. The chairperson for the committee will be Leisa Merrell.

#### **Ladies Clinics & Instruction**

The ladies Four & Pour will be back again in 2023! We will continue to offer this clinic/playing option on Tuesday afternoons starting in June and will run throughout the summer. The event will be from 4 pm to 6 pm that will include a clinic the first 20-45 minutes and the remainder of the time spent playing holes on the golf course. Most ladies stay at the club for dinner and drinks after the session concludes. This is a great starting point for any female looking to start the game of golf or looking to pick the game back up! The professional staff will be handling these events and is a great way to get introduced to the game in a fun and non-threatening atmosphere.

Ladies Get Golf Ready Clinics will be on Thursdays in May from 6 pm to 7 pm: May 4 Putting, May 11 Short Game, May 18 Irons and May 25 Woods. These clinics will be at a more affordable price: \$40 per clinic and \$120 if you attend all four. With the golf course closing on August 1st, we will also have clinics every Tuesday in August and September from 5 pm to 6 pm.

Take a look at the golf calendar and see that the committee planned out getting all the major golf events scheduled in May, June and July before the course shuts down on August 1<sup>st</sup>. We encourage all of you to get the dates on your calendar so we can have great participation.

We will continue to take \$5 out of every tournament entry fee to make a donation into the scholarship fund at the end of the 2023 season. This scholarship will assist the caddies who apply for the Evans Scholarship but do not become a finalist.

As we enter the 2023 season, Todd and his staff of professionals have agreed that we need to continue the strong momentum built in the last seven seasons by honing our program to ensure our kids are trained and ready to be excellent additions to your game. We'll be leveraging the strength of our experienced Meridian Hills caddies as they have the course knowledge that's critical as we train new kids. We feel our newer caddies will get the on-course knowledge given by our caddies that know our course and learn the finer points of the caddie-player interaction from those Scholars who have been on the job for years. As we always do, we will include work on how to forecaddie so one of our caddies can help with yardage, green duties, finding lost balls and bunkers when everyone in the group is riding.

We are very excited to announce that we have 48 caddies coming back for the 2023 season that had 10 or more loops from last season. These are all wonderful kids that would represent the scholarship and our Club in an outstanding fashion. Zach Hall is our caddy master and he has been making personal visits to the local middle and high schools in recruiting kids that will be new to our program. We are hoping to have three to five finalists at the end of the 2023 season. #### SIGN-UP PROCEDURE FOR 2023

If you have participated in 5 of the last 7 Timberman Classic Invitational's, then you are guaranteed a spot in the 84-team field. All other participants' names will be put in a lottery system that will be drawn on March 17<sup>th</sup> before the Indoor Putt-Putt Event. Every year you have participated in the event will get you one entry into the lottery. (EXAMPLE: A 3-year participant will receive 3 entries + this year's entry for a total of 4 total entries for the 2023 Timberman Classic). All participants that have played in at least 5 of the last 7 Timberman events will be notified by the Professional Staff and will have a deadline of February 13<sup>th</sup> to commit. All lottery participants will have until March 17<sup>th</sup> to sign-up on ForeTees.

If you are in the lottery and your name does not get picked you will go on to the waitlist. If you do not play in the event but are on the waitlist, then you will receive an extra entry for the 2024 Timberman Classic. IF YOUR NAME DOES NOT GET DRAWN FOR 2022 & 2023, YOU WILL AUTOMATICALLY QUALIFY FOR THE 2024 TIMBERMAN.

- A \$250 deposit will be billed to members' accounts on April 30th, 2023
- Anyone who cancels after April 30th will be credited \$100, and a \$150 administrative charge will remain


